

Personal Assistance

- Bathing, grooming, hygiene and dressing assistance
- Mobility assistance

Transportation

Services are available in either the client's vehicle (no additional fee) or caregiver's vehicle (per mile charge).

- Running errands (grocery shopping, bank, pharmacy, etc.)
- Providing transportation to grocery store, bank, appointments, religious and social activities, etc.
- Providing transportation to visit friends, family and neighbors
- Escorting client to breakfast, lunch, dinner

Specialty Services

- Home safety check**
Staff from Age at Home will come to the client's home to conduct a safety check and provide a printed report with the results.
- Family caregiver coaching/Caregiver website**
Clients and their caregivers will receive access to Age at Home's caregiver website, which provides tips and resources for caregivers. Upon request, Age at Home will coach family caregivers who assist in caring for loved ones.
- Facility services**
Caregivers are available to sit with and monitor a client during the client's stay in a hospital, rehab unit, sub-acute-care or skilled-nursing facility, memory-care unit or hospice.
- 24/7 care**
Caregivers are available in the home 24/7 while providing care from our menu of services.
- Overnight services**
Caregivers are available to assist client with preparing for bed and any needs throughout the night. This service can be performed on an 8- to 12-hour basis.
- Discharge/outpatient services**
Caregivers are available to assist clients during admission to and/or discharge from a hospital, nursing facility, outpatient clinic or surgery center; caregivers accompany clients while transferring between the facility and their place of residence, and remain until client is settled.
- Cognitive-support programming**
Client-specific care planning for those suffering from Alzheimer's, dementia or other cognitive challenges; an individualized approach ensures care takes into account the client's life history, routines and preferences.
